TEN THINGS YOU CAN DO TO ABOLISH CORPORATE PERSONHOOD

1. Establish an "Abolish Corporate Personhood" affinity group in your community.
2. Form a study group using the ten-session Challenge Corporate Power, Assert the People's Rights materials, or form a shorter study group that focuses specifically on corporate personhood (session III and other materials). *
3. Write letters to the editor and/or opinion articles, and call talk radio shows and public access TV to add to the public discussion the illegitimacy of corporate personhood.
4. Use street theater, such as mock citizens' arrests and trials of local corporate "persons."
5. Make presentations to community civic and religious organizations to educate people about corporate personhood.
6. Design programs for community access TV, develop sound bites for media interviews, and engage local artists in making posters for public events, bus ads, etc.
7. Circulate public petitions and resolutions for presentation to your city council; organize a campaign to establish a corporate personhood-free zone in your community.
8. Collect and publicize statements of support from elected officials and other well-known people.
9. Research and publicize ways in which the community is prevented from stopping a corporation from harming people and/or the environment because of corporate personhood "rights."
10. Incorporate language, analyses and actions challenging the legitimacy of corporate personhood into "traditional" peace and justice organizations and actions.
